- 2 locations with individual active directory domain respectively
- Retain privileges has been assigned to users in each locations
- Increase efficiency of domain administration

- Migrate 2 domains into a master domain with a sub-domain. Delegate rights to sub-domain in China for daily administration

- Ease management of 2 domains by a common console

China Star Products merged 2 active directories

China Star Products (CSP) is a leading supplier of infant bedding products in South China. CSP headquarters in Hong Kong and 3 factories locates in Dong Guang. There are around 150 users. 3 factories in Dong Guang are connected via fiber and high power Wi-Fi. IPLC is deployed to connect HK headquarter and Dong Duang factories.

The first active directory was deployed in Hong Kong 4 years ago and then Dong Guang was migrated from NT to active directory also. Both are separated domains since user group were small and that was easier to install.

AXISYS help CSP to merge both active directories without major service interruption. All of the users' privileges were retained. A sub-domain was created in Dong Guang instead of an individual domain. Sub-domain was delegated with all necessary rights to the local system administrators respectively.

“Administrators in Dong Duang could fully control local system efficiently but master domain unaffected.” said Raymond. “Administrator in Hong Kong now can control over the corporate active directory structure with single console.”
